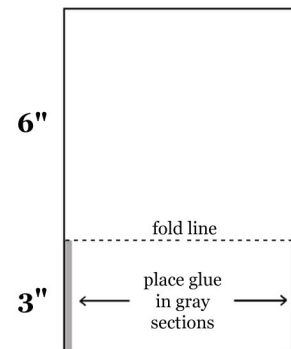
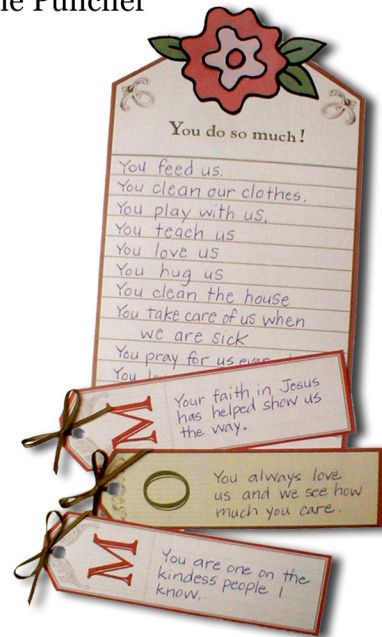
What We Used:

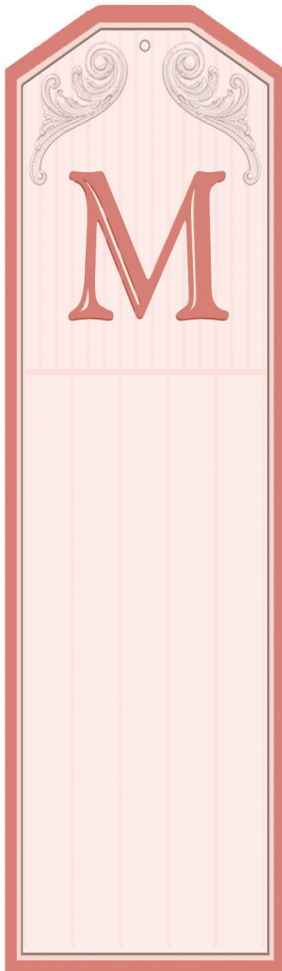
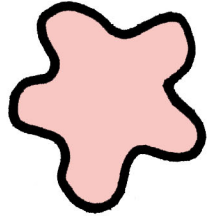
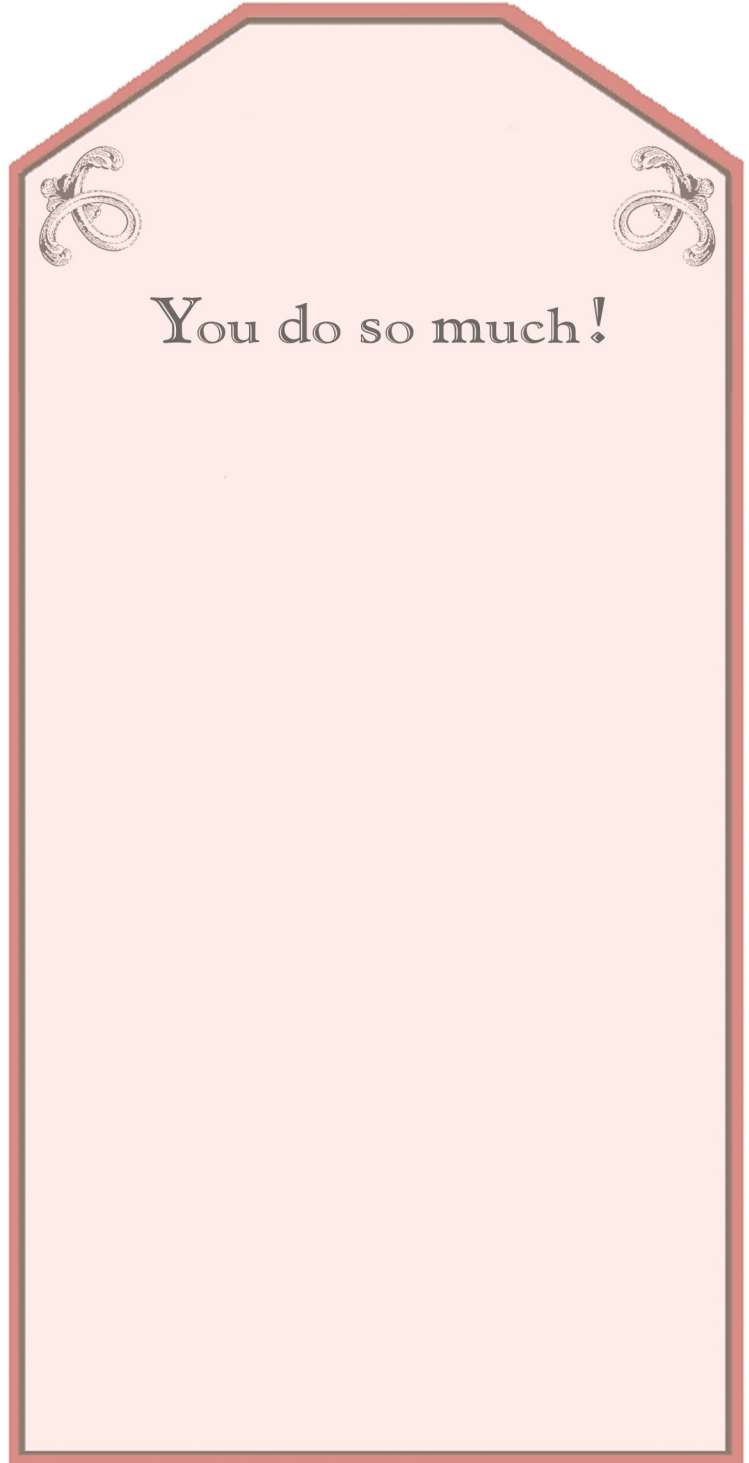
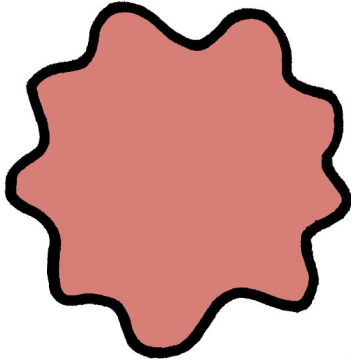
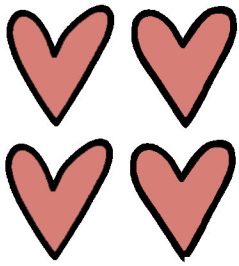
- * Color Ink for Your Printer
- * 3 Pieces of White Card Stock Paper
- * 2 Pieces of Light Tan Card Stock Paper
- * 1 Yard of 1/8" Dark Olive Ribbon
- * Glue Stick * Pen for Writing
- * Scissors * Hole Puncher

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Using color ink print out these 3 pages on white card stock and then cut the pieces out.
2. Your mom probably has many jobs around your house, she might be a cook, a nurse, a teacher, a preacher, a chauffeur, and a maid all in one. Maybe you can even think of some other jobs your mom does too. Take some time now to think about all your mom does. On the large tag that says, "You do so much," write down all the things you are thankful for that your mom does for you. You may want to stop and ask the Lord to help you.
3. Then fill out the other 3 tags that spell out "MOM." You may want to write about qualities you see in your mom that make her special. Maybe she is especially kind or giving. Maybe she is a wonderful example of a Christian to you. Just spend some time prayerfully considering what you want to say to her.
4. Glue the flower and leaves onto the large tag so it looks like the above picture and onto the smaller tags, punch holes then tie the bows.
5. Fold one of the tan pieces of paper in half so it measures 8 1/2" x 5 1/2."
6. Cut the other tan piece of paper so it measures 9" x 5 1/2." Then fold it so one side measures 3" and the other side measures 6" as shown. Place a small amount of glue along the sides, so when you fold the 3" section up it forms a pocket.
7. Place a small amount of glue down the 6" side, so that you can place it on top of the card (step 5) and form another pocket.
8. Glue the green checkered band to Panel B just 1/4" above "Happy Mother's Day" and then glue on the 3 hearts as shown. Center and glue Panel B onto the bottom pocket of the card.
9. Glue Panel A onto the middle pocket 1/4" down from the top edge, tucking the HTT copyright into the bottom pocket. Place weights on top of the card until it is dries.
8. Put your tags inside their pocket as shown in above sample and write something sweet on the inside. Make sure you sign it!
