



SANDPAPER MAN



What we used:

- * one sheet of sandpaper (yields 1 front and 1 back)
- * cardboard
- * Puffy Paint (red, green, yellow, white & black)
- * 5" of a thin red ribbon or red string for tie
- * Tacky Glue
- * scissors
- * hole punch
- * 3/16" green satin ribbon for bow (optional)

1. Use the pattern we included to cut out your sandpaper men. You can cut out a front and a back with a standard sheet of sandpaper. Then use the same pattern and cut one out of cardboard for the middle.
2. Glue the sandpaper onto the cardboard. One for the front and one on the backside of the cardboard.
3. Punch your hole in at the top.
4. Use the Puffy Paint and give a white border (as shown). If a young child is doing the painting you may want to wait and let it dry before you apply the other colors.
5. Decorate the rest of the Sandpaper Man using the other colors.
6. Give plenty of time to dry thoroughly and then tie your string through the hole on top.
